A MESSAGE FROM NOEL

It was a different Easter Day for me, in fact quite strange really as it was the first time that I can remember that I was not with a church congregation to celebrate the wonderful festival of Easter. No matter where I have been at this time of the year, I have always been able to join a Christian congregation somewhere to shout out that "Christ is Risen!".

I remember being in the congregation of the Greek Catholic Church in Jerusalem at midnight when the shout came and eggs were being smashed and the crowds went ballistic and the priest had to keep ringing the bell to remind the excited congregation that the liturgy hadn't finished yet! Can't imagine Anglicans doing that!

The strange and disturbing time we are now in, reminds me of the need we have to be together at worship time. We are a diverse crowd of people at Holy Trinity from all walks of life and interests, ages, ethnicity, sexuality and personalities, yet we have a common thread that is so important on Easter Day that the belief in the Risen Lord Jesus is our Saviour and that binds us together. We are the local faith community and we need each other on our journey of faith. I can hardly wait when the doors are flung open on that first Sunday and the family of the church gather to give thanks and celebrate the Easter mystery. That "Christ is Risen, He is Risen indeed!".

- Now is the time to read the resurrection appearances in the bible, check out the last chapters of the gospel writers. My favourite is the story of the road to Emmaus, though I like the thought of Peter jumping out of the boat to get to the shore first to greet the risen Lord on the beach.
