The Port Philip Area Deanery had an online meeting last week and all the parishes' and agencies' clergy were in attendance along with Bishop Geneive. The Bishop and the Area Dean Kathryn Watt, wanted to know how the clergy were getting on and how were the parishes functioning in these strange circumstances. It was interesting to note that each one of us was doing something to keep in touch with the congregation. *Some were able to provide the Sunday* liturgy online like St Silas Albert Park and All Saints St Kilda. The parishes that provide meals for the needy - Christ Church St Kilda, St Luke's South Melbourne, St Silas Albert Park, have all been able to continue their community service with the help of volunteers and the generosity of local cafes and restaurants. Chaplain Inni from the Mission to Seafarers told us that he has been able to be in touch with more ships and their crews than ever before because of social media. He was particularly pleased that he was able to be in touch with 'missing ships at sea' those who are not able to call into ports as they are closed. However he was able to contact the crews who are now stranded at sea and not able to return to their homes.

What is apparent, that despite the difficulties that the virus has caused, the church has found new ways of proclaiming the good news of the resurrection of Christ.
